Logistics & Registration Information

In accordance with the payment rules established by BSA, summer camp at Hawk Mountain Scout Reservation is a non-refundable program. Once the Scout has signed up and has made the initial deposit the Scout (and his Parents) are responsible for payment of the remaining balance due. If a Scout becomes unable to attend, every reasonable effort will be made to find a substitute Scout. If however, no substitute can be found, the Scout (and his Parents) will still be responsible for the Scouts portion of the Summer Camp Program and any applicable travel expenses. In general the following reasons are acceptable cause for a refund: Summer School, Family Relocation, Doctors Medical Excuse, or Death in Family.

Scout Fee Schedule:

- February 1, 2010 - \$30 Non-Refundable Deposit Due with Completed Activity Sheet
 - May 10, 2010 – Remaining Balance Due
 - Base Camp - \$270 Due
 - Base Camp + COPE - \$286 Due (must be at least 13 years old)
 - Boots and Paddles - \$365 Due (COPE not available)
- Qualifications for Boots and Paddles:
 First Class, 14 years old by first day of camp, pass swimmers test and Scout Master approval.
 Late Payments will result in additional fees.

Program and Activity Information

Base Camp: All Scouts qualify for Hawk Mountain Scout Reservation, which offers a full Base Camp experience: a Pathfinder Program for First Year Scouts; COPE, BSA Lifeguard and Extreme Sports for older Scouts. A wide range of merit badges in aquatics (including small boat sailing), conservation, scoutcraft, shooting sports, handicraft and outpost camping are offered.

Boots and Paddles: Scouts 14 years and older. Scouts will take a two day backpacking trip on the Appalachian Trail and a two day kayaking trip on the Schuylkill River. Scouts will be in base camp with their unit on Sunday, Wednesday, and Friday nights. Scouts will complete the Leave No Trace Award, Kayaking BSA Award, 50 Miler Award, Wilderness Survival Merit Badge, and Whitewater Merit Badge. Kayaking equipment, tent, backpack, and sleeping bag will be provided. Scouts may use their personal backpack and sleeping bags if these items are approved by the Boots and Paddles Director.
