Logistics & Registration Information

Participants must be Fourteen (14) years old by September 1, 2011.
 In accordance with the payment rules established by BSA Sea Base this is a non-refundable program. Once the Scout has signed up and has made the initial deposit the Scout (and his Parents) are responsible for payment of the remaining balance due. If a Scout becomes unable to attend, every reasonable effort will be made to find a substitute Scout. If however, no substitute can be found, the Scout (and his Parents) will still be responsible for the Scouts portion of the Sea Base Program and any applicable travel expenses.

Program and Activity Information

The mere name invokes visions of white sandy beaches and crystal clear water. This is an excellent description of the area you will be cruising on the Bahamas Adventure. The Florida Sea Base maintains several sailing vessels for crews of 6-8 to explore the vast underwater wilderness of the Sea of Abaco in the Bahamas. Crews depart from Marsh Harbour, Abaco, Bahamas. There is ample opportunity to snorkel the reefs in and around the islands as well as fishing while you are under way. This is truly the adventure of a lifetime, but don't expect luxury. This is a working voyage. Handling lines, preparing food, and fully participating in the operation of your vessel. If your plans call for visiting exotic places such as Green Turtle Cay, Hopetown and Little Harbour in a foreign country and snorkeling in absolutely translucent water, this is the adventure for you. Steady breezes, the protection of the barrier islands and the reef surrounding Abaco Sound provide perfect sailing getaways. This is a seven-day adventure.
