Logistics & Registration Information

Participants must be Fourteen (14) years old by September 1, 2011.

In accordance with the payment rules established by BSA Sea Base this is a non-refundable program. Once the Scout has signed up and has made the initial deposit the Scout (and his Parents) are responsible for payment of the remaining balance due. If a Scout becomes unable to attend, every reasonable effort will be made to find a substitute Scout. If however, no substitute can be found, the Scout (and his Parents) will still be responsible for the Scouts portion of the Sea Base Program and any applicable travel expenses.
